





MORE THAN 180 YEARS OF HISTORY

How it all started

VUB originated from the French-speaking Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB), which was founded in 1834 by a Brussels lawyer with Flemish roots, Pierre-Théodore Verhaegen. It was his intention to create a university independent from church and state with academic freedom at its core.

The Solvay Conferences 1911 - 2014

The International Solvay Institutes for Physics and Chemistry, located in Brussels, were founded by the Belgian industrialist Ernest Solvay in 1912, following the historic 1911 Conseil Solvay, considered to be a turning point in the world of Physics. The 1911 conference was attended by among others Albert Einstein, Max Planck, Niels Bohr, Marie Curie, and Henri Poincaré.

Ernest Solvay

(16 April 1838 - 26 May 1922)

Ernest Solvay was a Belgian chemist, industrialist and philanthropist, who after his successful establishment of the company Solvay & Cie, used his considerable wealth to set up the Institute for Sociology at the ULB in 1894, as well as the International Institutes for Physics and Chemistry. In 1903 he set up the Solvay Business School, which today still forms part of the ULB and VUB.





Usquare

VUB and ULB are working with the Brussels Capital Region on the Usquare project. It will mean a new university neighbourhood on the site of the former barracks of the gendarmerie to turn them into a new, lively neighbourhood with room for university services as well as housing for families and students. It will have an interdisciplinary research centre that creates synergies between incubator, StartLab and FabLab. The project is also being given an international dimension, with housing for students and researchers and with international reception spaces.




On the boundary between the VUB and ULB campuses in Brussels, a new building will emerge in a few years' time. The new study centre will offer new learning environments to students from both VUB and ULB: silent rooms for individual study, rooms for course work in groups, experience centres for activities for smaller groups and active learning rooms. Moreover, the ties with external partners from the corporate world will be tightened through project and exposition spaces.






About 57.22% has a permanent contract and 29.56% works with a temporary contract. 8.37% is self-employed and only 1.90 is working as an interim.





INCLUSIVE UNIVERSITY

The ALEF Project Arabic Language Classes Project Culture starts with your own identity

VUB started a project on Arabic language courses for 6-15 year old children in Brussels. It is the first Arabic language course in Belgium with academic supervision. The curriculum is checked by specialists and PhD experts in Arabic language. Each lesson contains extra learning activities next to the regular teaching, such as games, Arabic songs etc. Students receive a certificate of attendance by VUB. The children are taught by highly educated refugee teachers who fled their homeland due to war. When people get opportunities, we strengthen society. The more languages we speak, the better we

understand one another.



The ALEF project will be expanding to include a Minor in Arabic Language and Culture for the whole VUB student body.

For Students Student Refugee Programme and InCAMPUS

The VUB launched its Student Refugee Programme in 2015-2016. The intake of refugee students has increased since then, with a majority coming from Syria, Palestine, Iraq and Afghanistan. In 2018, the VUB added a specific track to the student refugee programme, called InCAMPUS for those refugees who need more help in terms of language, study guidance and psychological support.






